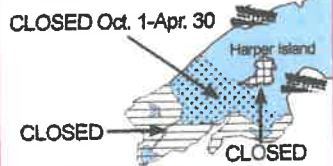

New: Sprague Lake Fishing Regulations- May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2011.

Species	Limit	Min Size	Additional Rules
Trout	5	None	Only 2 over 20". When fishing with bait, all trout are counted as part of the daily limit whether kept or released.
Large Mouth Bass	5	None	Only bass less than 12", except 1 over 17" may be kept.
Bluegill	25	None	Crappie and Bluegill 25 combined
Crappie	25	9"	
Channel Cat	5	None	

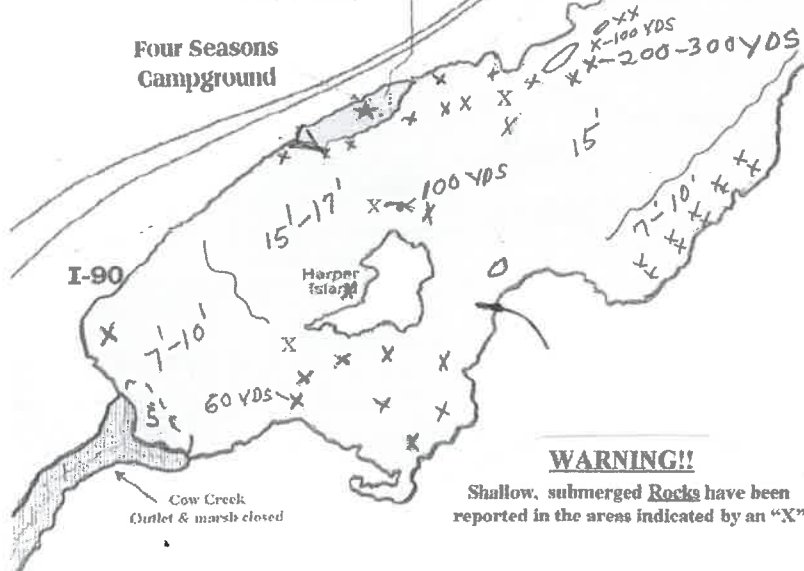
CLOSED WATERS - those waters of Cow Creek and the marsh at the SW end of the lake from the lakeside edge of the reeds to Danekas Rd. the small bay at the SE end of the lake, and those waters within 50' of Harper Island. Oct. 1-April 30: those waters SW of the SW tip of Harper Island closed to fishing. Note: Closed waters will be indicated by markers and signs displayed at the public boat launch.

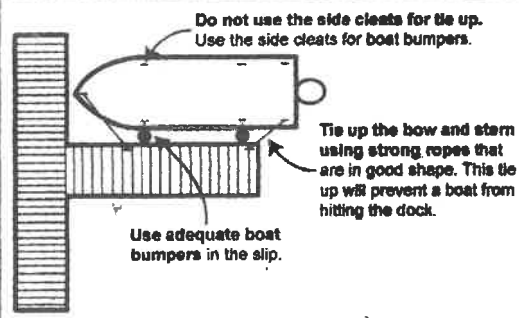
